Focusing Upward

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. **Colossians 3:1-4**

It is increasingly easy to be distracted as this world continues to turn, and our society spirals further from what we believe that God has intended. The church needs to remain diligent in being a positive influence for each other, and the communities that are left to our care. In our current state, where we are required to accept additional tasks and responsibilities, it becomes easy to become distracted, burnt out or both.

The verse above gives us a great reminder on how to deal with the weight of the things that we experience in this life. "Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things" may seem like a menial command, but it contains all of the power that we need to continue our quest to fulfill God's plan. When I consider the message of these verses, it is easiest for me to illustrate its importance using the scale of time. As humans, we think of time on a very abbreviated scale, from our earliest memory to the present. For some of the more mature church members, that is could be considered a significant period of time. For others, it could be considered very brief. As we look God's point of view, it is a very miniscule in the grand scheme of things. This is why it is so important for us to make proper use of our time and continue on the path He intend. Ultimately, we do not have any time to waste.

When you become frustrated, and at the end of your rope, focus on Him, and the promise of eternity that He has given us. It will make what you are struggling with meaningful and restore its worth.
