GO CERTIFICATES

Discipleship Opportunities

We wanted to share some information about some *GO* Certificates that provide seminary type instructions for those who want to be better equipped to teach or who just want to learn more.

The *GO* Program at SEBTS is a dedicated educational system for Christians provided by quality, Baptist seminary professors. They are designed to train leaders within churches to have a practical, deeper understanding of Scripture. Each certificate program contains seven courses in a specific field. Courses contain five 20-minute lectures per week and each course takes around six weeks to complete. Each certificate can be completed in a year. The cost for each certificate is \$679. These courses are a great opportunity for you to dive into Scripture as you seek to understand and communicate it effectively. Here are 4 of the certificates that are currently available.
