Yes for Life

Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute.
Prov. 31:8

Next week, Kentucky voters will have an opportunity to stand up for life in Kentucky by voting "Yes for Life" on Amendment #2. I know I have written about protecting life a lot the past few years but this is such an important opportunity for us to stand together against any who might try to find abortion rights in Kentucky's constitution even though there are no such rights. I have seen and heard a lot of misinformation about Amendment #2. I want to try to make sure we understand what amendment actually says. The amendment reads as follows: "Are you in favor of amending the Constitution of Kentucky by creating a new Section of the Constitution to be numbered Section 26A to state as follows: To protect human life, nothing in this Constitution shall be construed to secure or protect a right to abortion or require the funding of abortion?"

This amendment does not create or prevent any other laws. This amendment will prevent judges from reading their personal opinions into the constitution and coming up with a right for abortions in Kentucky. There are multiple organizations that are using scare tactics about the life of a mother and pregnancies that are caused by rape or incest. Such pregnancies account for less than 1.5% of abortions and this amendment in no way precludes our representatives from writing laws as they see fit to protect people.

Scriptures teach that all human life is created in the image of God and we should defend and support life from conception to natural death. I think that as Christians we are called to speak up for those (like the unborn) who cannot speak for themselves. I will certainly be voting YES to amendment 2 and would encourage you to join me in voting YES! I am also praying that Kentuckians will lead the way in protecting the lives of the unborn in America.

As mentioned in the past, not only do we want to stand against abortions, we want to do all we can to support the work of local pregnancy resource centers (like Care Net Pregnancy Services of Northern Ky and New Hope Pregnancy Center) as they seek to support mothers who are trying to navigate unexpected pregnancies. These pregnancy resource centers provide pregnancy test, ultrasounds, parenting classes for mothers and fathers, adoption advice and assistance, and other support services. Additionally, I was talking to a foster mother this week and she was telling me about the great need for more foster care families in Kentucky. If we can assist you in pursuing foster care, please let us know.
