



## Thank you for the Kindness

Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. **1 Thess. 5:18**

I just wanted to offer some words of thanks! I appreciate the cards, kind notes, and gifts so many of you sent this month for pastor appreciation. You all do a good job of making me, and our staff, feel appreciated and supported. It is an honor and a privilege to serve the Lord's church and specifically with the people at Burlington Baptist. You are a very gracious congregation. I also appreciate the way you have ministered to the Mosley, Robinson, and Rice family the past couple of weeks. I appreciate the ones who took food to some of the families and to those who helped with the bereavement meals. It is such a blessing to be able to provide a meal for a family after they get done with a funeral.

It was a blessing to have 10 people attend our Next Steps class on Sunday. I was encouraged by the ways many of them felt welcomed and supported by the church family. It was also encouraging to hear their desires to be a part of BBC and to find an area to start serving. Additionally, we had about 15 visitors on Sunday (some were children). It is always a blessing to have people visit with us on Sunday. I want to encourage you to continue to invite your friends, neighbors, and associates to visit with us at BBC. We are looking forward to a fruitful fall.

We are just two weeks away from election day. I want to continue to encourage each of you to go vote and, in particular, vote Yes for Life (Amendment #2). I'll plan on writing more about this amendment next week but it is so important in the fight to protect the lives of the unborn for that amendment to be passed. Amendment #2 will simply ask, "Are you in favor of amending the Constitution of Kentucky by creating a new Section of the Constitution to be numbered Section 26A to state as follows: To protect human life, nothing in this Constitution shall be construed to secure or protect a right to abortion or require the funding of abortion?" This amendment will be the last item on the ballot and might even be on the back side. While some states and political parties are going all out to provide abortion rights at any point of the pregnancy, we want to stand up for the protection of the unborn in Kentucky. Please be intentional about voting "YES" for Amendment #2.

This Sunday, we will have somebody here from New Hope Pregnancy Center to share a little bit as to how we can support their work. Not only do we want to protect the lives of the unborn, we also want to support mother's who are might be dealing with an unexpected pregnancy or a single mother who might struggle raising a baby. New Hope Pregnancy Center (located in Crestview Hills) provides pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, Motherhood and Fatherhood classes, as well as adoption agency referrals. We support Care Net Pregnancy Services of Northern Kentucky (annual baby bottle change collection) and also want to partner with New Hope Pregnancy Center as they walk alongside mothers in times of pregnancies.

October is flying by and this Sunday will be a 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday. We will observe the Lord's Supper this Sunday. We also invite you to bring some items to help with our food pantry. Food items that go along with a thanksgiving meal would be much appreciated. Other helpful items include canned vegetables, fruit, peanut butter, jelly, laundry detergents, and personal care items (like toilet paper). As prices continue to go up, the needs of those in our community will likely increase. Thank you for the ways that you give generously to help meet some of the needs around us. The coats that Ms. Ina has collected for students at Burlington Elementary are greatly appreciated!!!
