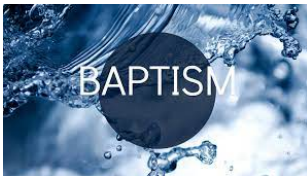

Keep on Fighting

Then all the Israelites, the whole army, went up to Bethel, and there they sat weeping before the Lord. They fasted that day until evening and presented burnt offerings and fellowship offerings to the Lord. And the Israelites inquired of the Lord. (In those days the ark of the covenant of God was there, with Phinehas son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, ministering before it.) They asked, "Shall we go up again to fight against the Benjamites, our fellow Israelites, or not?" The Lord responded, "Go, for tomorrow I will give them into your hands." **Judges 20:26-28**

I have gone a bit off course from our study through the Apostle Paul's prison epistles to something that I feel is important in both my ministry, and general Christianity in our current culture. It relates to the idea that Christians are expected to take the Gospel and conform it to an ideology that is acceptable and more comfortable. We see evidence of this everywhere we look in the wide-angle lens that makes up our current secular and church cultures. It is often a difficult task to stand on a particular conviction as it will often be those who you thought were on your "team" that supply the most opposition.

In the above passage of Scripture from the book of Judges, one of my favorite Old Testament books, we find that the nation of Israel finds themselves in a very costly battle with a group that is part of their own. In this selection, the Israelites have been in two previous encounters that were highly damaging losses. They humbled themselves before God, and were faithful in their preparation, and the willful obedience to accomplish the plan that He has intended for them. A very important word in the interpretation of verse 28 is "asked" or "inquired." They did not demand that God deliver their brothers to them but were sensitive to His instruction.

So do not give up or quit on what God has convicted you of. His word is living and timeless, and does not need to be conformed to man's ideas. Keep your focus and be diligent in the task He has for you.
