

Reopening Childcare and Preschool

Pre- Registration

- Preschoolers (Infants-PreK) must pre-register at reopen.church/r/el30LB3u before arrival (space in classrooms are limited for the safety of our preschoolers).

You should NOT come into the building if...

1. You have a fever of 100 degrees or higher.
2. You have any respiratory infections, or have had a cough, sneezing regularly, had shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
3. In the previous 14 days, you have had any contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of Covid-19; is under the investigation for Covid-19 or is ill experiencing a respiratory illness.
4. In the previous 14 days, you have traveled on a cruise or internationally.

Upon Arrival:

All staff and children will have their temperatures taken upon arrival (touchless thermometer) and will be screened with the four statements above. If your child has a temperature of 100.5 or higher upon arrival, your child will not be allowed to stay. If a fever develops during their time in the classroom, the child will be removed from other children and parents will be called for pickup.

Preschool Drop off and Pickup Procedures

- Each preschooler (Infants-PreK) must have a reservation to be admitted into the classroom .
- Please take your child to the restroom before checking in to a classroom.
- Only one parent/ guardian will be allowed in the preschool area for drop-off & pick-up (**No siblings**).
- A limited number of people will be allowed into the preschool area at one time (Thank you for waiting patiently to enter).
- Enter and exit the preschool lobby by following the arrows (one way).
- Everyone's temperature will be taken upon entering the preschool area.
- The check-in stickers will be given to both the child and parent.
- Please pick up your children immediately following the end of service so there is time to clean and sanitize the classrooms.

Preschool Area Procedures:

- Hand sanitizer will be located at the entrance.
- No diaper bags/tote bags of any sort should be sent with your children. If you need to send supplies or a change of clothes, please put the items in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name and instructions.
- Those children who are still using bottles or sippy cups may have a second Ziploc bag with written instructions provided for the teacher.
- Staff and children will be required to wash their hands upon arriving in a classroom. Teachers will prompt children to wash their hands regularly while in the classroom.
- Greeters/screeners and classroom teachers will wear masks.
- Teachers use gloves when diapering and following good hand washing hygiene. Changing tables will be cleaned and sanitized after each use. These are already practiced procedures.
- Our teachers will continue to disinfect rooms between services. Toys that are used by a child will be removed and sanitized before another child uses it.
- Playroom surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized between classes.
- There will be no shared supplies. Each child will be provided personal supplies for projects & activities.
- Snacks - No snacks will be given.
- Classroom doors will remain open for better airflow/ ventilation.
